



2020 General Excellence Boarding Scholarships/Bursaries

A range of scholarships and bursaries exist for new boarding students who wish to commence at Ballarat Grammar and can successfully demonstrate a capacity to contribute to the life of the School in the broadest sense.

A record of contribution and achievement across areas such as sport, community service, leadership, cultural activities and visual / performing arts, as well as academic pursuits, will reflect the commitment and good character of successful applicants.

Scholarships and bursaries are usually offered for the duration of studies as a boarder to the end of Year 12 and offer partial remission of Boarding fees.

Students who have already received a scholarship or bursary under the annual Academic / Music / Art and Design / Performing Arts Scholarship program are **not** eligible to apply.

These scholarships relate to entry in 2020.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Complete and submit the "Application for Enrolment and Student Details" form if not previously lodged (ignore the \$100 fee at this point), **and**
2. Attach a portfolio (digital copy if possible) including the following documents:
 - Covering letter/email titled "General Excellence Boarding Scholarship"
 - Semester 2, 2018 School report (if not previously provided)
 - Most recent NAPLAN report (if not previously provided)
 - Copies or list of certificates/awards from school or other involvements
 - Details of involvement in co-curricular activities including sport, music, community or and other area/s of outstanding achievement
 - Any other relevant information (if applicable)
 - Kindly note on your application if you are a member of ICPA
